Hole Setup

Each Hole Host is responsible for bringing and setting up their own display.

Please bring anything you'll need, including:

- *Tables and chairs*
- *Decorations*
- *Games or activities*
- *Promotional materials*
- *Tents or shelters (if desired)*
- *Speakers or music (please be respectful of neighbouring holes)*
- *Extension cords or generators if required*

If you're planning something larger, such as vehicles, trailers, or oversized props, please contact the Golf Club ahead of time so you can ensure your setup can be accommodated safely.

Be Prepared

You'll be at your hole for the duration of the tournament, so please come prepared.

We recommend bringing:

- *Sunscreen*
- *Plenty of water*
- *Snacks and lunch*
- *Chairs*
- *Shade or shelter*
- *Clothing for changing weather*
- *Comfortable shoes and anything else you'll need to enjoy the day!*

Arrival & Setup

Hole Hosts will be transported to their assigned holes before the tournament begins. We will be on location by 9:30 a.m. Please know golfers will be on the course before our tournament starts, please be respectful of current players during your set up.

Please ensure you have enough time to set up before the 12:00 p.m. shotgun start.

Arrive early enough to unload and be ready before golfers arrive.
